The Maritime Institute of Technology and Graduate Studies (MITAGS) and Pacific Maritime Institute (PMI) offer one of the most versatile and cost-effective routes to your STCW Mate to Master (CMM) certificates.

Comprehensive

In addition to the required training, MITAGS-PMI also offers 121 of the 126 tasks/assessments within the various courses to help minimize the inconvenience of trying to obtain these tasks at sea.

Cost Effective

The MITAGS-PMI Program can be completed in sixty (60) days for the current price of \$20,125. Our full CMM Program, which covers most of the U.S. Coast Guard requirements, is only twelve (12) weeks in length. If you take all of your CMM courses at MITAGS or PMI, you will receive a 10% discount (\$2,013) on the tuition. Additionally, we will provide a Radar Renewal and Flashing light exams at no additional charge (a \$428 savings). Note: The tuition rebate will be issued upon successful completion of all 12 weeks of training.

License Advancement Program (LAP)

If all of the CMM courses are taken at MITAGS or PMI, the student will also receive a ten percent (10%) discount off the cost of the License Advancement Program (LAP). Note: the current commercial list price for LAP is \$3,825.

Hotel Accommodations at MITAGS

MITAGS offers affordable overnight lodging in our spacious 232-room hotel complex. The all-inclusive overnight accommodations rate includes breakfast, lunch, dinner, break service, night lunch, free use of the recreational facilities, high-speed Internet access, and self-service laundry facilities. The commercial price is \$175 per night however this rate could be reduced to as low as \$149 per night based on the number of consecutive nights you stay in the hotel. Rates are subject to change.

A free, 24-hour shuttle service is also available to/from the Baltimore-Washington International (BWI) Thurgood Marshall Airport and the BWI Amtrak Train Station.

This STCW-2010 compliant training program is designed for the experienced officer in charge of a navigation watch (Second & Third Officers), who are ready to upgrade to the Chief Mate / Master Management level. This complete program offers all the mandatory and optional training and assessment completion to upgrade to the management level of Chief Officer/Mate.

The MITAGS-PMI CMM program is six weeks (30 days) of USCG National Maritime Center (NMC) approved training and simulations that provide you with the knowledge, skills and confidence to assume the duties and responsibilities of a Chief Mate and Master. Where applicable; advanced simulations are incorporated into the courses. MITAGS-PMI has prepared more deck officers to move up to the management level than any school in the United States.

Please note that as of 24 March 2014, with the implementation of USCG NVIC 10-14(CH-1) and NVIC 11-14 (CH-1) the following courses are MANDATORY, but do NOT complete all other remaining assessment tasks as required by the NMC are:
