MITAGS WEST Safety Plans – COVID 19 Policies

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MITAGS WEST – FULLY VACCINATED CAMPUS

All students, staff and faculty on campus, regardless of the length of time on campus must be vaccinated against COVID-19, subject to any medical exemptions required by law and any religious exemptions. Exemptions must be related to a documented medical issue or a religious objection AND proof of Negative Covid test (taken within 72 hours) for every person entering the facility is required. Please see footnote 1. Any exemptions must be submitted in writing.

- Students will need to verify that they have been vaccinated with Admissions before the start of their course.

All persons must present proof of vaccination or an exemption with a negative PCR COVID test within the last 72 hours. Rapid tests are not accepted. Acceptable forms of vaccination verifications are:

- Vaccine card or photo of vaccine card
- Documentation from a health care provider
- State immunization information system record
- Hard copy or electronically signed self-attestation (provided in this document)

Per Washington State Department of L&I, MITAGS WEST has verified vaccination status of employees.

WE ENCOURAGE ALL STAFF/STUDENTS TO STAY HOME IF YOU FEEL SICK, OR IF YOU HAVE BEEN IN CLOSE CONTACT WITH A CONFIRMED POSITIVE CASE.

Face Masks/Coverings

Face Masks are required inside the facility regardless of vaccination status per Washington States' indoor mask mandate (8/18/2021).

Physical Distancing

Physical distancing is no longer required per Proclamation 20.12.4 for Fully Vaccinated Campus'.

Cleaning, Disinfectant and Sanitization

Students, guests, and employees have the responsibility to sanitize their own personal workstations. All common areas will be cleaned by assigned staff daily. MITAGS West will make all reasonable attempts to provide disinfecting supplies throughout the accessible common areas, classrooms, and work stations, subject to availability.

Firefield

Masks required at the Firefield. Our shuttle service to/from the firefield remains suspended indefinitely.

Third Party Facilities – BASIC TRAINING, BT REVALIDATION & BT REFRESHER COURSE

MITAGS West utilizes third party pools for Basic Training. According to the King County Department of Health, these pools will require proof of vaccination or proof of Negative Covid test (taken within 72 hours) for every person entering the facility every time they come:

- *Proof of vaccination will be required for each entry to a recreation facility, for every visit. Vaccination proof will not be stored.*

The following are the several different ways we can verify proof of vaccination (the easiest is to bring their card):

Staff will check for the following acceptable forms of vaccination upon each entry to a recreation facility:

- [CDC vaccination card](#) or photo of vaccine card.
- Documented proof of vaccination from medical record or vaccine provider.
- Printed certificate or QR code (available at the end of September) from [MyIRMobile.com](https://myirmobile.com).

For people who are unvaccinated, proof of a negative PCR Covid test a maximum of 72 hours before entry:

- *People who are unvaccinated or cannot prove vaccination status will be required to show proof of a negative PCR COVID-19 test taken in the last 72 hours. Documentation must be from a testing agent such as a laboratory, health care provider, or pharmacy. Self-administered rapid tests (also called at-home tests) will **not** be accepted.*
- *Vaccination exemptions will not be accepted. Proof of a negative test can be shown for those who cannot be vaccinated.*

Violations of COVID-19 Policy

The MITAGS WEST Assistant Director is the person responsible for monitoring and implementing the campus COVID-19 Policies. Any violations of the COVID-19 Policies by students, guests, or employees must be reported immediately and directly to the Executive Director. Students, guests, and employees may also report such violations to the Executive Director or his designee. Deliberate violations of this policy may lead to removal from the campus, and employees may be subject to disciplinary actions.

The privacy of any person reporting a violation of the COVID-19 policies shall at all times be respected and shall be treated confidentially, to the extent possible and only disclosed to the extent permitted by law. No students, guests, or employees who make such a report shall be subject to retaliation or any adverse action based upon making such a report.

Please stay home if you are sick, have COVID-19 symptoms, or if you test positive for COVID-19. This requirement applies even if you are fully vaccinated.
